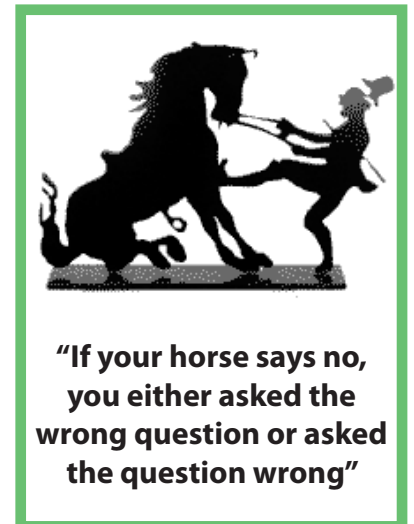

In his day he was shown by Cory Hutchings, Lisa Hammons, Cally Lervick, Annie Steensa, Mackenzie Neal, and numerous students learning to ride. He was a world champion in 13 under trail, got his youth championship many times over, and the overall NWCC High Point in 13 and Under and Walk Trot. He'll be deeply missed.
