New classes and new faces bring increased entries to 2013 APHA World Show Successful APHA Open/Amateur World Championship Show drew 2,583 entries

FORT WORTH—The American Paint Horse Association is celebrating the successful conclusion of its 2013 World Championship Show, which was held November 6-16 at Will Rogers Memorial Center in Fort Worth, Texas.

In addition to naming 168 World Champions over the course of 11 days, APHA held a total of 242 classes and paid out more than \$500,000 in cash and prizes.

New opportunities brought an increase in entries over the 2012 Open/Amateur World Show. When the dust settled and the final champion was named, the show had 935 horses with a total of 2,583 entries. Forty-two states, Mexico and Canada were represented.

New in 2013, APHA hosted a pre-show boot camp to help Amateur and Novice Amateur exhibitors polish their skills. A "Ride The Pattern" seminar gave exhibitors first-hand insight into what the World Show judges would be looking for in patterned classes.

The lineup of new class offerings was well received: four new Green classes accounted for 114 entries; Paint Barrel Racing Incentive Program (PBRIP) Sweepstakes gathered 49 entries with total payout of \$16,130; Ranch Sorting Sweepstakes drew 49 entries with an estimated total payout of \$13,825; and the inaugural Ranch Horse Pleasure Sweepstakes saw 15 entries with an estimated \$4,025 purse.

Farnam's 2-Year-Old Western Pleasure Stakes and 2-Year-Old Hunter Under Saddle Stakes paid out \$50,000 to horses that had been consigned to the 2012 Stakes Session of the Farnam/APHA Breeders' Trust Select Sale. The anticipated payout is even larger for 2014.

Held separately in conjunction with the APHA World Show, APHA and the United States Team Roping Championships (USTRC) hosted the Cowtown ShootOut roping at Will Rogers Memorial Coliseum November 15-17. The Cowtown ShootOut was the largest roping held in the historic coliseum and drew 1,230 teams. USTRC paid out \$211,561 cash, buckles and saddles. APHA and Farnam teamed to pay an additional \$4,000 incentive to Paint ropers in two divisions, along with beautiful Gist Silversmiths trophy buckles.

"It's always exciting to see growth in World Show participation. This year's show was both a testament to the improving quality of entries and the willingness of APHA leadership to innovate. We're already thinking about ways of growing the show even more," said APHA Executive Director Billy Smith.
