



#### **November General Membership Meeting.**

• Revision in Minutes for October minutes: previously zone one reps received for each meeting \$125. Also requested to put number of years on board members terms on second page of newsletter.

**Breed show.** Last proposal, BC paint club does not have enough funds to go in with us for a show next year, so it has been proposed to putting on a two day show. Lola calculated that it takes 50 horses to break even, a decision needs to be made soon because the facility will not be held for us for long. The show would have open classes along with APHA classes so it would become an open show and APHA show and each would have their own hi points.

• The proposed date would be the first weekend of June.

**NWCC and ZONE ONE.** Staci brought the NWCC and Zone one meeting minutes for people to look at. The reps for this upcoming year will be Jessica Thorndycraft and Staci Johnson and we agreed that we would pay Jessica the \$125 for the meeting she went to this year.

• New Business: Zone is moving and had discussions about where to move Zone next year.

#### **Board Members Meeting Minutes:**

We need more members and brainstormed ideas to promote the club. Lola previously made brochures for the club and is going to update them with incentives for people with all breeds of horses and activities that we hold like the trail ride, judging clinics and shows. Want to target people that don't necessarily show on the paint circuit or have paint horses, such as trail rides, year-end open show awards, trail riding awards, and the youth scholarship.

As of now officers do not pay membership fees, voted to stay the same and passed.

Currently we pay the treasurer a year end fee, voted to stay the same and passed.

When we have board member meetings we requested that the treasurer to report all expenses monthly, voted and passed.

We need fundraising, it was estimated that for the 2015 year until now that we have spent \$2318 in expenses to run the club. More ideas to raise money or to save money are always accepted and talked about during our meetings. One idea is a gaming show since our high population of youth gamers in Skagit County. During that discussion we did add barrel and poles to our show with an open jackpot.

Voted on putting our show on for June. In order for it to be successful we need big sponsors and lots of helpers. It was passed for June 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>.

We have had troubles this year getting enough people to the meetings in order to have a quarum for voting. It was discussed to change the bi laws instead of having a certain amount of officers or board members to having a percentage of membership at the meeting.
