

## 2012 Show Rules – APHA Breed Show – PNPHC and RPHC

1. DOGS – Due to legal liability, the Tacoma Unit will not allow ANY dogs (unless for medical necessity) in the barns or area. We recognize many of you travel with your dogs – they are welcome, but only if you keep them at your camper and ON LEASH at all times. Thank You for your cooperation.
2. NSF checks will be assessed a \$35 fee
3. Exhibitor Responsibility – See APHA Rules - exhibitors are responsible for being knowledgeable of and for following the current rules, completing entry form legibly and accurately, reporting to the gate promptly, and being considerate of other exhibitors and show management. Additionally, exhibitors/ owners/ trainers are responsible to be knowledgeable of RuleSC-085 regarding drugs & medications that are forbidden or conditionally permitted. Conditionally permitted substances require a completed medication report be filed with the show office. We are here to help you so please ask if you are uncertain about anything.
4. The show secretary must inspect the registration papers (or copies of) on each horse entered. Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owner. Geldings are not allowed to show with stallion papers.
5. To enter Amateur or Novice Amateur classes or Novice Youth classes, or Amateur Walk/ Trot, you MUST present a current year APHA Novice / Amateur card OR complete an application for an APHA Amateur or Novice Amateur or Novice Youth or Amateur Walk/ Trot card and return it to the show secretary prior to entry in a class.
6. Youth exhibitors must present a current AjPHA membership card.
7. All exhibitors must present a current APHA membership card.
8. The condition of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of APHA & PNPHC and RPHC rules.
9. The final right to settle all questions or disputes arising incidentally to the Horse Show is reserved to the Show Management. All exhibitors, trainers, riders, or other participants agree in advance to be bound thereby to such methods of settlement.
10. Individual class entry will close (3) classes prior to entry of that class. Entry at the gate accepted at the discretion of show management.
11. Anyone withdrawing (scratching) from a class without a THREE (3) class prior notification shall forfeit their entry fee in accordance with APHA Rules (exception - non-point classes).
12. Show management may combine or split classes according to APHA Rules.
13. Ties will be broken by (1) most firsts, (2) most placings, (3) flip of coin.
14. Awards MUST be picked up by end of show or be forfeited.
15. Any RV, trailer or vehicle parked blocking an electrical hookup space WILL BE CHARGED the electrical hookup fee even if it is not used.
16. It is understood all participants welcomed at the Tacoma Unit #1 will be respectful of all common areas and use as posted.
17. It is understood all exhibitors will be mindful of posted fire lanes and emergency vehicle areas.
