DIRECTIONS

24717 43rd Ave NE, Arlington, WA 98223

From I-5 Northbound, take exit #210, (236th St.), turn right off the exit, from **From I-5 Southbound**, turn left off the exit. Turn left onto 19th Ave. NE. Follow road approx. 1.5 miles. Turn right on 43rd Ave., follow to the barn.
From Highway 9 Northbound, turn left onto 252nd St. (Kackman Rd.), from **Southbound Hwy 9**, turn right onto 252nd St. Turn left onto 43rd Ave., follow to the barn.

SHOW RULES

Helmets/ Hunt Caps required for all Riders 16 and under.

Show attire is NOT required but will be considered in High-Point placings; Boots are required for all exhibitors.

Abuse of animals or show personnel will not be tolerated. Judges and show management have final say.

Show Management reserves the right to combine, split, cancel or re-arrange order of classes or divisions as they see fit.

No refunds will be given; however, "open checks" are welcomed and shall be calculated after add/drops. All accounts must be settled on the day of the show. A \$50 charge will apply for any check returned for non-sufficient funds.

Absolutely no stopping and backing up on the rail.

Cross entry between Walk/Trot/Jog and Canter classes is allowed; however, you must declare your high-point.

Novice entries are defined as any one horse/rider combination having not won three or more first placings.

Registration papers are required for ALL Breed Specific Classes

We will take a 30minute Lunch Break after class #32, class #33 will not start before 12Noon.
