



January General Membership Meeting.

Ryan started the meeting at 7PM and minutes were passed for the January newsletter.

Bi Laws – Bi Laws were discussed again as to how many people it takes to have a quorum and if the rule was changed, there were concerns of having enough people at the meetings. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Treasurer's report – The money we currently have from scholarships and help fund has gone into the general checking fund and it was discussed that funds can be separated again when we get youth active in the club again. There was a motion carried out by Lola to simply keep track of the hi point award money coming out of the general checking when we need it and to combine funds that we currently have.

BBQ – Sheila and Tabi are taking it on again this year and will share news when it comes up.

Breed Show – Ron Coakley is announcing again and we have 2 couples that are our judges which will save on hotel expenses. APHA had problems getting our show results tabulated and contacted Lola who re formatted the results and re submitted them in. This issue came up from the secretary from our show, along with a couple other issues that we will discuss with her.

This year's show we want to bump up the youth presence. A proposal of \$75 stalls for youth or possibly a \$275 one kid/same horse flat fee. We also talked about lowering the fees for walk trotters or people that don't show the APHA classes but have APHA horses. Staci made a motion to lower the youth stall fee to \$75 which is for all youth for both shows. Passed.

Our goal line to break even for our show is to have 50 horses, we want to aim higher this year so we can have a successful show, Ryan purposed to have the last 5 years of trainers names who have attended our show to create a guideline list to send emails and send cards out in the mail. Sue has envelopes from the club to send out. Some things that are different this year from some of our past shows is a change of Venue, a new date earlier in the year, and not back to back with other shows.

We already have Platinum Performance and Metcalf Feed donating to our show. Ryan thought of having a day to go out as a small group and hitting up some local businesses and farms for sponsorships. Lola passed around a headstall with engraved cheek pieces that fit into our budget for Hi Points and are very nice.

Permanent Numbers – Tabi has volunteered to take over the task and will email Angela to talk about getting forms and information about how it is run.

Paint Promotion – Rachelle was talked to about paint promotion for the breed and the club and she is thinking about it.

New Business -- Ryan wanted to talk about incentives for new members to attend meetings and become new members, talked about raffles at every meeting and printing our own shirts and apparel to help promote our group. DC Printing does Tabi's 4-H club apparel and is very affordable. For the next meeting Tabi will bring some ideas for prize awards for the club ride.




